Details:

- This is a request for grant proposals of up to \$500 to be used for enrichment opportunities for the students of East Ramapo public schools. The number of awards given depends upon available funds and the quality of applications received.
- Applicants must be public school teachers in grades K-12 in the East Ramapo School District. Librarians, teaching assistants may also apply for grants if their program is sponsored by an East Ramapo public school teacher.
- Projects may include but are not limited to the following areas: STEAM, art & cultural enrichment, Literacy and Wellness (including social, academic, athletic and emotional wellness) technology, trips, athletics, clubs and any materials that teachers deemed educationally enriching.

- Awards will be announced in late February, 2019, allowing teachers to implement them in the Spring.
