



## **David Katcher Memorial Scholarship**

The **David Katcher Memorial Scholarship** was created to celebrate the memory of David Katcher, a 2001 graduate of Nanuet High School who passed away much too soon in December 2017.

David was a loving son, brother and friend. He excelled in music and if you went to any high school musicals during his high school years, you saw David on stage, playing piano. The David Katcher Memorial Scholarship Fund would like to honor a student whose own passion is for the arts – not necessarily as a college major or career choice, but as an important part of life.

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a promising Nanuet High School senior who dedicates extracurricular activities to the performing arts, to assist with costs of a college education. The scholarship recipient is selected by a committee composed of the Nanuet HS Music Department faculty, Nanuet Music Parent Volunteers and a member of the Caulk family, and is overseen by the Rockland Community Foundation scholarship committee.

### **Qualifications:**

Applicant must be a graduating senior at Nanuet High School, planning on attending an institution of higher learning, and must show commitment and contribution to the Nanuet Performing Arts Department.

Applicant must plan on being involved in an aspect of the performing arts (for example, but not limited to, music, theater, stage technology, recording industry, performing arts education, arts administration) while at an institute of higher learning, whether as a field of study or as an extracurricular activity.
